GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED AT THE FACULTY PREMISES

By considering the current situation of the country related to COVID-19 outbreak, it is extremely important to adhere to precautionary measures in order to prevent COVID-19 spread among the students and other University staff after reopening the University for academic activities. Your attention regarding following health related guidelines by adhering to which, COVID-19 related risk within the University premises can be significantly reduced.

3rd year students (batch: 2017/2018) of the Faculty of Livestock, Fisheries & Nutrition, Wayamba University of Sri Lanka are requested to agree and conduct work as per the rules and regulations stipulated below.

- Practical Sessions for batch: 2017/2018 will be commenced on 01st December 2021.
- Any student who feels COVID -19 symptoms when you are in the faculty premises will have to immediately report it to the Assistant Registrar or any other staff member through the telephone.
- If anyone has any respiratory difficulty or fever, do not come to the faculty premises and stay at the hostel after informing to the relevant authorities.
- Wearing a mask and a face shield is compulsory at all times in the faculty premises, canteen, lecture rooms, laboratories, corridors, and other common places (wear and dispose correctly). Further, you are requested to use a personal hand sanitizer all times to clean your hands.
- Avoid touching high-touched places such as doorknobs, counter tops etc.
- Students are requested to report to the faculty premises only before 15 minutes from the commencements of the practical sessions.
- Students are requested to maintain at least one-meter distance with each other at common places.
- Students are requested not to share personal items or meals.
